The garden is divided into different garden areas or 'rooms', with new vistas and surprises around every corner. Red Cow Farm is a dream for anyone with a green thumb. This afternoon we make our way to Canberra ready for the excitement of the Floriade Festival tomorrow.

We spend the morning here with free time to wander around at our leisure and to purchase lunch. This afternoon we spend the time travelling home, arriving later today with many tips and ideas maybe to try in the home garden.
